DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision in the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) program, the Emergency Medical Services Specialist Level I/II reviews, evaluates, coordinates, and monitors the activities of the emergency medical service providers within the County.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Either: 1. One year of full-time paid experience as an Emergency Medical Technician, Paramedic, Mobile Intensive Care Nurse, Army Medic or Navy Corps-person.

Or: 2. Two years of full-time paid technical, administrative, or analytical experience within a state or local governmental Emergency Medical Services program.

Note: Current licensure as an Emergency Medical Technician, Paramedic, or Registered Nurse is desirable.

- Individuals in provisional positions must be reachable on the eligible list to be considered for permanent appointment.
- If a provisional is not reachable, it is the appointing authority's responsibility to take the appropriate action to terminate the appointment. Civil Service Rule 7.5 states, "Provisional appointments shall terminate within twenty (20) calendar days after the date on which the eligible list is established."
